### **TIN REGISTRATION**

The Fiji Islands Revenue and Customs Authority (FIRCA) wishes to advise the general public that it is deploying more staff in the Nasese Office to receive and process applications for the purposes of Tax Identification Number (TIN).

As of today, additional staff has been deployed at the Suva Customer Service Centre to assist in the TIN Registration.

The general public is advised that urgent cases such as Land Transport Authority (LTA) renewals and bank account cases will be processed at the counter provided it is supported by documentary evidence.

TIN for non-urgent cases will be posted to the respective taxpayer on the given postal address.

FIRCA will give priority in processing applications from senior citizens and disable persons.

Currently the FIRCA Road show team in conjunction with Commissioner Western is available in the District Offices as scheduled below to assist in the TIN registration as well as attending to other tax enquiries:
