VERIFICATION WITH ELECTRONIC MANIFEST

- A. With effect from 02 January 2007, the copy of the SAD to be released will be subject to verification against the electronic manifest by the Manifest Officer based at the Long Room.
- B. The Manifest Officer will stamp "ENTERED" on the release copy after it has been verified against the particulars of the relevant consignment in the electronic manifest.
- C. The OIC Wharf on receipt of the release copy will again verify the particulars of the release copy against the hard copy of the manifest with relevant consignment before writing it off with the SAD receipt number.
- D. The Shipping Company or his agent will raise the delivery docket against the particulars on the SAD and manifest. The OIC Wharf will verify and write off the manifest against the delivery docket stamped "DELIVERY APPROVED" prior to proceeding to the gate where the cargo presented will be verified by the proper officer there before the cargo is released.
