



**FIJI ISLANDS REVENUE & CUSTOMS AUTHORITY
PUBLIC CIRCULAR NO. 7 OF 2007**

**LICENSING OF AIRPORTS, SEAPORTS, SUFFERANCE AIRPORTS,
SUFFERANCE WHARVES AND OTHER BONDED CUSTOMS AREAS.**

Owners and operators of all International Airports, Seaports, Sufferance Airports, Sufferance Wharves, Bonded Consolidated Freight Stations, Bonded Export Freight Stations and Other Bonded Customs Areas are advised that with the coming into force of the Customs Act (Budget Amendment) Promulgation No. 14 of 2007 with effect from 1st July 2007, they will need to obtain an operating licence from the Comptroller of Customs.

The owners and the operators of the above areas shall make an application in writing to the Comptroller of Customs.

If approved, a licence will be issued upon payment of an annual fee of **\$1,755.00** (One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty Five Dollars).
