



**FIJI ISLANDS REVENUE & CUSTOMS AUTHORITY  
PUBLIC CIRCULAR NO. 9 OF 2007**

**TEMPORARY CARGO STORAGE AREA**

All Shipping Companies, Airline Operators, Shipping and Airline Agents, Container Freight Operators and Other Cargo Handling Agents are advised that no cargo will be permitted to be transferred to any place for temporary storage of goods unless that area is approved or licensed by the Comptroller of Customs as a BONDED CONSOLIDATED FREIGHT STATION or BONDED EXPORT FREIGHT STATION or BONDED CUSTOMS AREA.

Only cargoes that are consigned to the operators of the licensed Bonded Consolidated Freight Station or Bonded Export Freight Station or Bonded Customs Area through a Master Bill of Lading or Master Airway Bill shall be transferred.

Other Cargo handling agents, who wish to have their cargoes handled by one of the licensed Bonded Consolidated Freight Station or Bonded Export Freight Station or Bonded Cargo Area operator, will require prior approval from the Comptroller of Customs. Approval may be given subject to compliance with certain conditions as the Comptroller of Customs may require. The liability of the cargoes will be the responsibility of the operators of these Areas who will be handling the cargoes.

Manifests of all consolidated cargoes shall be electronically provided to the Comptroller of Customs as required under Customs laws. A security shall be provided for any such transaction.
